WEEK	OF
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MAIN TRUTH: God wants you to talk to Him in prayer

TO DO AS THE CHILDREN ARRIVE:

- 1. Greet the children; make them feel welcome.
- 2. Take attendance.
- 3. Listen to previous week's memory verse.
- 4. Have children put money in missions bank.

PRE-SESSION ACTIVITY:

- 1. OLDER CHILD: "Why Be Thankful?"
- 2. YOUNGER CHILD: MOSES #12 Activity Sheet

PRAYER:	(4 minutes)

MEMORY VERSE: (8 minutes)

<u>1 Corinthians 15:57</u> – "<u>But thanks be to God</u>, who giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (The underlined portion of the verse indicates what the younger children should memorize. See "Involvement Helps for Younger Children" for helps in teaching the verse to the younger children.)

"Choose a Time of Day" – After you have read this verse from the Bible, explained what it means, and repeated it at least two times, you may begin this drill. Name a time of day (i.e., when making your bed, in class at school, on the playground during recess, watching TV in the evening, etc.) when you need God's help to say "no" to sin. Recite the verse again and choose a different time of day to talk about.

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BIBLE LESSON: (20 minutes)

(See "Involvement Helps for Younger Children" for ways to involve the children in the Bible lesson.)

<u>COUNSEL TIME:</u> (If you have a helper, hostess, or Teacher Junior Grade, let them do the review time while you counsel those who responded to the invitation. Otherwise, at the end of club, be sure to remind the children who responded to the invitation to stay after club for a few minutes.)

<u>QUIET TIME NOTEBOOK:</u> (1 minute) Briefly highlight what was learned from last week's Quiet Time. Ask the children to do one per day.

- 1. Sing "God's Way" while child comes to look in the "Go and Tell" Box.
- 2. Share missionary information for Week #17 using the "Go and Tell" Box. (See attached page.)
- 3. Pray for the missionary.

- 6. Story: Secret in the Woods. Teach the portion of the story listed under Week #7.

REVIEW ACTIVITY: (7 minutes)

Use the activity below or the Bible Learning Game from the "Involvement Helps for Younger Children."

"Secret Message" – Write the following blanks on a poster board for the secret message:

"_______." As each question is answered correctly, the child may guess a letter to go in the blanks. If the letter is part of the message, fill it in. After each letter is filled in, the child may try to guess the message: "Thank God at all times." If the message is guessed before all the questions have been answered, use a second secret message such as, "I can thank God for saving me." – MOSES, Law Giver, CEF Press.

Review questions for MOSES #12:

- 1. What did God do to punish the people for complaining once again? (Sent poisonous snakes into the camp.)
- 2. When Moses prayed and asked God to take the snakes away, what did God tell him to do? (Make a snake out of brass and set it on a tall pole.)
- 3. What was the only thing the people had to do to be made well? (Look at the brass snake.)
- 4. What happened to anyone who didn't believe and refused to look at the pole? (They died.)
- 5. How does the brass snake on the pole remind us of Jesus? (Like Moses put the brass serpent on a pole and lifted it up high, Jesus was nailed to a cross and was lifted up high for all to see. Anyone who "looks" to what Jesus did on the cross and believes that He did it to pay for their sins, will be forgiven.)
- 6. Did God allow Moses to go into the Promised Land with the people? (No.)
- 7. Why didn't God allow Moses to enter the Promised Land? (He disobeyed God and hit the rock when God told him to speak to it.)
- 8. What did God do for Moses because he would not be able to enter the Promised Land? (He allowed him to see it. He showed him the land from the top of the mountain.)
- 9. Why do you think God did this for Moses? (He loved him.)
- 10. Who buried Moses's body? (God did.)

*COUNSEL TIME: (*Only if you did not counsel with the children earlier.)

Why Be Thankful?



INTRODUCE THE VERSE:

What are some things that we should thank God for? (Allow responses and discussion). The biggest thing that we should thank God for is sending Jesus to take the punishment for your sins and mine. That's what our verse is about today.

READ THE VERSE:

Read the verse together from the visualized verse. Then read the verse directly from the Bible.



EXPLAIN THE VERSE:

1 Corinthians 15:57 - (Hands as an open Bible.)

This is the address (where the verse is located in the Bible). This verse is found in the book of 1 Corinthians, chapter 15, verses 57.

"But thanks be to God," - (Fold hands together as praying and look up. Point up toward Heaven.)

It's good to say, "thank you" when someone does something nice for you. We should thank God because He has done something wonderful for us. This next part tells us what He did.

"who giveth us the victory" - (Point to yourself. Make fists and lift arms in air, in victory.)

Each of us are in a battle against sin. Satan, God's enemy, is always trying to get us to sin and disobey God. This verse says that God gives us power to say "no" to sin; He will help us to win over sin. How?

"through our Lord Jesus Christ." - (Put fingers together to make cross.)

God sent Jesus, His only Son, to die on the cross for our sins. If you know Jesus as your Saviour, you can have victory over sin. You don't have to sin anymore. He will help you do what's right.

(Saved) Remember, if you know Jesus as your Saviour, God the Holy Spirit will help you say "no" to sin. If there is a sin that you are struggling to stop doing, pray to God and ask Him to help you win over that sin!

(Unsaved) Jesus died for your sin and mine. He wants to redeem you from (buy you back from; pay for) the punishment for your sins, which is separation from God forever. If you have never asked Jesus to be your Saviour from sin, you can pray to Him whenever you are ready. If you have questions or are confused about asking Jesus to be your Saviour, ask a leader today before you leave!

REPEAT THE VERSE:

"Choose a Time of Day" – After you have read this verse from the Bible, explained what it means, and repeated it at least two times, you may begin this drill. Name a time of day (i.e., when making your bed, in class at school, on the playground during recess, watching TV in the evening, etc.) when you need God's help to say "no" to sin. Recite the verse again and choose a different time of day to talk about.

MEMORY VERSE: Shortened verse

BIBLE LESSON HELPS:

Scene 1 — Walk slowly in place. Hang head like you are tired and discouraged.

Scene 2 — As Israelites, cry together, one phrase at a time, angrily, "No bread! No

water! We hate this manna!"

– Move hand as a snake crawling. Make hissing sound.

Scene 3 — As Israelites, plead with Moses, "Please, ask God to take the snakes

away!"

Scene 4 — As Moses, pretend to shape snake out of brass. Hang snake on pole.

Scene 5 — Ask, "What would you do if a snakebite on your body suddenly

disappeared?"

Scene 6 — Put hand on neighbor's shoulder and say to them, "Be strong and of good

courage!"

- Say together boldly, "Do not be afraid!"

- Sing to tune "God Is So Good" the following words, "I thank the Lord, I

thank the Lord, I thank the Lord, He's so good to me."

Scene 7 — As Moses, put hand above eyes and look out over the land.

BIBLE LEARNING GAME: "Say 'Thank You'"

Have children sit in a circle. Pass around a beanbag while singing to tune "Did You Ever See A Lassie?":

"Oh God wants you to thank Him, to thank Him, to thank Him.

Oh God wants you to thank Him for all that He's done."

Child holding beanbag at end of song names something he can thank God for doing for him. Verbalize that by saying, "*Thank You, God, for <u>(fill in child's answer)</u>,"* etc. Continue as before.

GO AND TELL BOX

Week #17 - What Do the Snavelys Do?

(Suggested item to put in the "Go and Tell" Box - DVD.)

What do you think a DVD has to do with *going and telling*? (Let the children share their ideas.)

WHAT DO THE SNAVELYS DO? (Show their show picture. Use WHAT wordstrip.)

We have learned in Good News Club/Released Time Class that missionaries have many responsibilities. Sometimes their responsibilities depend upon where they serve the Lord as missionaries and what ways they use in reaching people with the message of God's Word.

TEACH TEACHERS – (Use TEACH TEACHERS wordstrip.) Mr. Mike travels and teaches creation seminars (large classes) in churches. These seminars are attended by many different people: Christian school teachers, Sunday School teachers, children's worship teachers, and Wednesday night Bible club teachers. These people who teach children get many ideas to help them talk about how God created the world in their classes.

TEACH CHILDREN – (Use TEACH CHILDREN wordstrip.) Sometimes, Mr. Mike is invited into schools to present special classes on creation and evolution. Mr. Mike also does special programs for children and their parents in churches. Mr. Mike enjoys teaching children.

PREPARE VISUALS – (Use PREPARE VISUALS wordstrip.) Mr. Mike has written and produced DVDs that can be used in schools and homes by teachers and parents who are interested in learning more about God's wonderful world of creation. There is a video that explains the "Flood of Noah." Mr. Mike also did a series for children to watch and learn more about God the Creator.

LET'S PRAY FOR OUR MISSIONARIES

THANK God that DVDs are available to help teachers, parents and children understand the Bible's teaching of creation.

PRAY that the DVDs will be used to help children and grownups understand the truth of Biblical creation.

- At this time, not all of the people could talk to God, but Moses could...
- So Moses prayed & asked
 God to take away the snakes

FLASHCARD 5-4

- God listened to Moses & made one way the people could be saved from this punishment
- God said to Moses, "Make a snake & set it up on a pole for everyone to see...
- "If someone is bitten, let them look up at that snake on the pole, & they will live"
- Moses obeyed; Took some metal & made it into the shape of a snake; Set it on tall pole; So whoever was bitten could look at the snake & be healed

FLASHCARD 5-5

 This makes us think about Jesus

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- And the snake on the pole makes us think about Jesus & what He did to save sinners like you & me from the punishment we deserve for our sin
- Because even though the people deserved this punishment...
- God said if the people looked at the snake, believing God's promise to heal them, they would be healed
- This was a picture of Jesus because even though you & I deserve the punishment for our sin, if you look to Jesus, believing God's promise of forgiveness, you will have your sins forgiven

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- John 3:14 (Many years after Moses lived, Jesus said these words.) "...As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so...the Son of man (Jesus) be lifted up (nailed to a cross & die for sinners like you & me)."
- Anyone who was bitten by a snake & looked to the snake on

- the pole was healed; But anyone who would not believe what God said & did not look at that snake, died
- How sad that God made a way for the people to be saved from the punishment of their sin; But some refused
- Same is true today...
- After this trouble ended, the people could move on to where they would travel next...
- ...Until it was finally time to go into the land God had promised! And this time, they would go in & take it!

FLASHCARD 5-6

- But Moses would not be with them; Because disobeyed God in front of the people (hitting rock instead of speaking to it)
- As came near the land, God told Moses it was soon time for him to die
- Then Moses begged God, "Please choose a new leader; Don't let the people wander around like sheep without a shepherd to care for them"
- Moses had a special friendship with God; He talked to God about everything!

- If Jesus is your Savior, you can have a special friendship with Him too
- He wants you to come to Him about everything; He wants you spend time with Him alone every day to get to know Him & know how much He loves you!
