MEMORY VERSE REVIEW: (8 minutes)

John 14:6 – "Jesus saith unto him, 'I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me."

(The underlined portion of the verse indicates what the younger children should memorize. See "Involvement Helps for Younger Children" for helps in teaching the verse to the younger children.)

"Beanbag Toss" – After reading the verse from your Bible, explaining what it means, and repeating it at least two times, you may begin this drill. The group begins repeating the verse slowly. Toss the beanbag to any child. The child must then supply the next word. After the child says the next word, the entire group continues the verse until the beanbag is tossed by the child to another child. Again, the child who receives the beanbag says the next word followed by the group continuing the verse. Repeat as time permits.

REVIEW ACTIVITY: (7 minutes)

Use activity below or the Bible Learning Game from the "Involvement Helps for Younger Children."

"Tabernacle Concentration" – On the flannelboard, place a Tabernacle symbol behind each of the sixteen squares. The child who correctly answers the question earns 100 points for his team. He is also given a chance to match two of the symbols that are hidden behind the numbered squares. As he removes each of the squares, review the meaning of each symbol. If the two symbols do not match, cover them again with the squares. When the symbols do match, leave them uncovered. The child who matches the squares earns a bonus of 25 points for his team. – *Adapted, Give & Take*, February 1993





"The Way of Approach to God"

<u>John 14:6</u> – "Jesus saith unto him, '<u>I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me."</u>

(The underlined portion of the verse indicates what the younger children should memorize.)

- ✓ USE the visual and let the children read the verse with you.
- ✓ **READ** the verse from your Bible while holding the visual so the children can follow along.
- ✓ **DO MOTIONS** together with the children while you **EXPLAIN** the verse as follows:

(Hold hands as an open Bible.)

"Jesus saith unto him, 'I am the Way,'" (Raise one finger.)

"'and the Life;'"
(Raise three fingers.)

(Shake head "no" and cross hands back and forth in front of you. Then point toward Heaven.)

- Jesus is saying that He is the only way to get to Heaven.
- Jesus is God's perfect Son. He could never lie.

- Jesus is the only One who can give us life forever with God in Heaven when our life on earth is over.
- No one can go to Heaven where God lives on their own.
- You can't buy your way into Heaven with money.
 Doing good things, being baptized, or going to church will not get you to God. The only way is by trusting Jesus to be your personal Saviour.

GO AND TELL BOX

Week #21 – What Does Miss Nicole Do?

(Suggested item to put in the "Go and Tell" Box – "Jesus Loves You" in Russian, English, German, and ASL.)

What do all of these different languages have to do with going and telling? (Explain what the phrase means and which language is which.)

Listen carefully to what Miss Nicole does to find out why these languages are important to her.

WHAT DOES MISS NICOLE DO? (Show picture and use WHAT wordstrip.)

As we learned earlier this year, missionaries have many other responsibilities besides telling people about the Lord Jesus.

PREPARE VISUALS – (Use PREPARE VISUALS wordstrip.)

For Miss Nicole, the visuals that she is using to share the Good News with the deaf are the signs themselves! She is working on learning Romanian Sign Language so that she can use her hands to tell people about Jesus.

TEACH CHILDREN – (Use TEACH CHILDREN wordstrip.) Miss Nicole goes to a church in Romania along with several other missionary couples. The church teaches people in three languages—English, German, and Russian. They also have families and children from Ukraine coming to their church after the families had to move away from their homes because of war. They teach the children and teenagers in their church about Jesus.

TRAIN TEACHERS – (Use TRAIN TEACHERS wordstrip.) Miss Nicole and the other missionaries in her church have many opportunities to train other Christians to share the Good News. Miss Nicole usually works with women to teach them more about the Bible and how to follow Jesus. Recently, she had a young missionary woman stay in her apartment until the missionary could find a place of her own to live.

LET'S PRAY FOR OUR MISSIONARY:

THANK God for the many different people who come to Miss Nicole's church and hear about Jesus.

PRAY that Miss Nicole and others in her church would carefully prepare the Bible lessons so that they can clearly share them with the children.

- Would offer that animal as a sacrifice on something called the brazen altar (which was outside in the middle of the courtyard)
- That animal would die to make a covering for the people's sins
- That animal was a picture of Jesus & how He would die for us
- Perfect; He never did anything Just like that animal, Jesus was wrong

- But Jesus would let men who nated Him take and nail Him to a cross of wood where He would oleed and die
- covering for sin but would take away the punishment of sin - His death wouldn't just make a forever for all who would trust in Him as Savior from sin

- 1 Peter 3:18 "...Christ also the Just for the unjust, that He hath once suffered for sins, might bring us to God....

- But Jesus hadn't come yet so God told the people to bring these sacrifices
- So day after day, year after year the people would bring their sacrifices; But still it wasn't enough
- Because the blood of these animals could never take away our sin...
- So God told the Priests to offer these sacrifices for the people and only the Priests were able to go inside the Tabernacle
- As the Priest entered the Tabernacle he would walk into the first room, called the Holy Place
- In there he would see three things...

 The table of showbread that had 12 loaves of bread on it

- The golden lampstand that was to always be burning

 And an altar where the Priest would burn sweet smelling

incense, called the altar of incense

- Each of these three things was a picture of Jesus

Vol. 2, FLASHCARD 9

- At the back of the Holy Place was beautiful, thick veil (like a curtain); More than 18 inches thick!
- On the other side of that curtain was the most amazing place; It was called the Holy of Holies

Vol. 2, FLASHCARD 12

- Only one person could go in this place – the High Priest; And he could only go in once a year
- There was no lampstand or window inside this room; But it was not dark
- Because this is the place where God's presence would come to meet with His people
- When God's presence came there, the Bible tells us light filled the room!
- It was the light from God Himself, Showing He was with His people
- And in this room, was just one piece of furniture

- The bottom part was called the Ark of the Covenant; The top was called the Mercy Seat; Was made of solid gold!
- On each end of the Mercy Seat was a gold cherub (a special angel God made to worship Him in Heaven)
- This was the most special part of the whole Tabernacle; This is why...
- God promised, "I will meet with you from above the Mercy Seat"; This is the very place where God's presence would come so He could be near and meet with His people
- God loved His people; Wanted to be near them; Wanted fellowship (special friendship) with them
- If you know Jesus as your Savior, God wants this same kind of special friendship with you too
- But the way we do that today isn't by going to the Tabernacle and offering sacrifices...
- It's by spending time reading God's Word and talking to Him in prayer

MT - GOD WANTS YOU TO SPEND TIME WITH HIM

- God wants to meet with you every day and He wanted to be able to be near and meet with the Israelites too
- That's why they needed this Tabernacle; But we don't have the Tabernacle anymore do we?

- That's because when Jesus died something amazing happened...
- Veil that separated the Holy Place from the Holy of Holies (where God would come to meet with His people); God tore it from top to bottom!
- Showing that it was no longer just the High Priest that could be near God in His presence
- Bible tells us God no longer dwells in a Tabernacle made with hands – but if you know Jesus as your Savior, He lives in you!
- You can go directly to God yourself
- You can have a wonderful relationship with Him, talking to Him and spending time with Him every single day!
