

It is important for you to believe that God's Word is true!


Sometimes people lie or change their minds, but God never does that. Here are some things we know about God's Word, the Bible.

You will not be able to trust God or what He says in His Word if you do not know Him. That is why it is important for you to spend time every day reading God's Word and talking to Him in prayer.

Read the verses below to learn more about Who God is.



He knows all things.

"Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight..." (Hebrews 4:13).

God is All-Powerful. There is nothing that is too hard for Him!

"For nothing will be impossible with God" (Luke 1:37).

He is Ever-Present.

"God is our refuge and strength, and a very present help in trouble" (Psalm 46:1).

Pray. Thank God that He is Great and Wonderful!

2 Samuel 7:28 "...O Lord God, Thou art...God, and Thy words be true...."

Maybe you have heard someone say before that the Bible isn't true. Maybe your teacher said that God didn't really create the world in 6 days. Or maybe someone laughed at you when you said you believe the stories in the Bible are actually true.

Our enemy, Satan, wants you to doubt [not believe] what God says in His Word, the Bible. But you can be sure that God's Word is true and that It will never change.

Think about a time you were tempted to doubt what God said in His Word, the Bible. Pray. Ask God to help you believe that everything He says is true!


