Life of Christ #10

John 4:43-54

- Who knows the song, “My God is so Great, so Strong, and so Mighty. There’s nothing my God cannot do!” (Have children stand and sing with you)

- Have you ever really thought about that?

- There’s nothing God cannot do; That means there is nothing that is too hard or too impossible for God

- Maybe you’re wondering how I know that’s true; Well, our true story from the Bible today talks about that

- Remember who Jesus spoke with in our last lesson? (The woman at the well; Then the whole city)

- After Jesus left Samaria, He went on to Galilee; People there were excited to see Him

- Soon Jesus came to town of Cana; Nearby was a man with a big problem

- He was a nobleman; Probably important, rich, & in charge of many people

- One day, man’s servant might have come to him and

said, “Sir, your son doesn’t feel well.”

FLASHCARD 4-1

- Nobleman probably went right to son, put his hand on his forehead; He was very sick

- I’m sure the nobleman probably called a doctor, gave his son medicine, watched over him day and night

- But nothing helped! In fact, the son got worse and worse!

- Even though nobleman was a rich, important man, he couldn’t do anything to make his son well

- Must have realized his son was going to die; Nothing he could do to save his son’s life

- But somehow he had heard that Jesus was nearby in a town called Cana

- The nobleman must have known about how Jesus had turned water to wine

- He must have believed that Jesus had the power to heal his son!

- But how could that be? Only God could do something like that

- The nobleman must have believed Jesus had the power to heal his son! Maybe Jesus would!

FLASHCARD 4-2

- So off he went; His son was sick and there was no time to lose; He had to get to Jesus before it was too late!

- When he made it to Cana, maybe he rushed through streets shouting, "Where is Jesus?"

FLASHCARD 4-3

- Nobleman must have hurried to Jesus; "Please, will you come with me and heal my son? He is about to die!"

- Jesus must have looked at the crowd who was watching to see what He'd say

- Jesus, "Unless you all see miracles, you will not believe."

- Jesus knew most of the people were there just to see Him do a miracle.

- They didn't yet believe they sinned and needed Someone to save them

- But they were sinners who needed Someone to save them

- And boys and girls, so are you and I

- The people did not realize their sin and their need for Someone to save them

- Many of them were probably there just to see Jesus do a miracle!

- But the nobleman only cared about one thing

- He needed Jesus right that minute to come heal his son

- Nobleman, "Sir, please come before my child dies!"

FLASHCARD 4-4

- Jesus, "Go back home; Your son will live."

- When nobleman heard that, could have said, "How can You heal when my son is far

away?" or "How will I know for sure my son will be ok?"

- But nobleman didn't say any of those things because he knew Jesus had the power to do anything.

- He knew nothing was too hard for Him.

MT – YOU CAN KNOW THAT NOTHING IS TOO HARD FOR GOD

- The nobleman knew Jesus had the power to do anything, even heal his son from far away

- If Jesus said his son would be well, then it must be true

- So the nobleman started walking home

- It must have been late in the day so maybe the nobleman had to find a place to stay overnight

- Next morning he made the rest of the trip home

FLASHCARD 4-5

- Before he reached home, servants came to him

- I can imagine they were probably running toward him to tell him what had happened!

- Servants said joyfully, "Your son is alive! He is well!"

- Nobleman, "What time did he start to get better?"

- Servants, "Yesterday at about 1:00 in the afternoon

- Nobleman knew this was the exact time Jesus had said to him, "Your son will live."

- Jesus did what seemed impossible, but nothing is too hard for Him!
