Mark 5:21-43; Luke 8:40-54;

- People crowded around Jesus. They pushed & pressed, trying to get closer, trying to see Him
- He just traveled across Sea of Galilee with His disciples into town of Capernaum
- People there heard Jesus was coming and were excitedly waiting for Him

FLASHCARD 6-1

- In the crowd that day was someone who was determined to get to Jesus
- His name was Jairus, a ruler in the synagogue
- Most Jewish rulers hated Jesus and wanted to stop Him. But Jairus desperately needed Jesus to help him

FLASHCARD 6-2

- When Jairus reached Jesus, fell down at His feet
- "My daughter is sick & is going to die."
- Jairus' sick daughter was 12 yrs. old. Jairus loved his daughter; Was desperate for Jesus to come and heal her

- Jesus followed Jairus to his home, making his way through the crowd

- Probably was slow getting there. People crammed together around Jesus

FLASHCARD 6-3

- In that packed crowd was a woman with terrible problem
- For 12 yrs. she had a sickness that made her weak
- She'd gone to many doctors & paid lots of money, but they couldn't help her
- Years passed; She spent all her money; Instead of getting better, she was getting worse
- This was a serious problem; But she had a problem that was much worse.
- We have same problem too

- Sin is serious; The woman in this story had problem of sin, and was also very sick

- The woman heard that Jesus was in her town, but He was on His way to heal someone else

- How could she even get to Him through huge crowd?

- Even if she did get to speak to Jesus, she may have been afraid & not sure what to say

- Her problem was embarrassing; To the Jews, she was considered an unclean person

- If anyone touched her, would be unclean too; Maybe Jesus wouldn't want to touch her

- As she looked at crowd and saw Jesus walking with Jairus, she had an idea

- "If I can just touch the bottom of His clothes, I know I will be healed."

- This woman was so sure of Jesus' power, she believed just touching His clothes would heal her! She was right

- How? Could you do this? If someone touched your clothes, could you heal them? No! But Jesus could because He's God the Son!



- This woman was right to believe Jesus could heal her

- So, pushing forward, woman came up behind Jesus, reached out her hand; Touched bottom of His clothes

- As soon as she did, she felt in her body that her sickness had stopped

- She was completely healed!

- Jesus immediately realized that His power had gone out of Him to heal someone

- He turned around; "Who touched My clothes?"

- The disciples...surprised!

- Peter said, "Master, this crowd pushing & bumping You; How can You ask, 'Who touched Me?'"

- Jesus; "Somebody touched Me because I know that power has gone out of Me."

- Jesus could tell that this touch was from someone who did it on purpose; He looked around to see the woman who had done it

- He wasn't too busy to stop & care for her; He loved her

MT – REMEMBER THAT JESUS LOVES AND CARES FOR YOU

- Jesus wasn't too busy for the woman who touched Him

FLASHCARD 6-4

- When the woman saw that Jesus knew what she had done, she stepped forward

- She was so afraid, was shaking; She fell in front of Jesus, told Him the truth

- Jesus said gently; "Daughter, be of good comfort. Your faith has healed you; Go in peace."

FLASHCARD 6-5

- Just as Jesus was saying these things, someone from Jairus' house came up to him

- "Your daughter is dead. Don't trouble the Master anymore."

- It would have been easy for Jairus to think Jesus didn't care about him; After all, Jesus could've stopped this from happening, but didn't

- Have you ever been tempted to believe Jesus doesn't care about you when hard things happen?

- Jesus loved and cared for Jairus and wanted him to believe that

- Jairus thought there was no reason to bring Jesus to his house now; It was too late

- But as soon as Jesus heard that the little girl had died, He turned to Jairus; "Do not be afraid; Only believe."

- If Jairus would trust Jesus, Jesus could still help him, even though this terrible thing happened

- When they arrived at Jairus' house, all the friends & neighbors of Jairus' family were there, crying loudly and playing music

- This was the way people in those days showed sadness when someone died

Jesus asked; "Why do you make all this fuss and cry? The little girl isn't dead; She's only sleeping."

- The people laughed at Jesus; They knew the girl was dead

- Jesus commanded everyone to stay outside...

- ...Except for the mother & father of the little girl & His disciples—Peter, James, John
