

DAY - 1



If you know Jesus as your Savior, there is good news! God, the Creator of this whole world, is strong enough to do anything and promises to help you. He wants to give you the strength you need to say "No" to sin and defeat the enemy.

When Satan tempts you to sin, pray! Ask God to help you say "No" to sin and do what is right.

DAY - 2

When Satan tempts

If you know Jesus as your Savior from sin,
Jesus lives in you and promises that

'I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee."



Hebrews 13:5



Who will be with you and help you when you are tempted to sin?

Do you know Jesus as your Savior?
Knowing Jesus as your Savior means believing
Jesus is God the Son and that He did these things
for you (Read about it in the verse below):

"...Christ [Jesus] died for our sins... and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day...."



1 Cor. 15:3-4

To receive Jesus as your Savior from sin, you must believe that...

If you do not already know Jesus as your Savior and you believe that Jesus is God the Son and that He is the only One who can save you from your sin, you can tell God something like this.

If you believe these things, He will keep His promise, and He will save you!

DAY - 3

When Satan tempts you to sin, believe!

God can give you the strength you need to say "No" to sin.

"He [Jesus] who is in you is greater than he [Satan] who is in the world."



1 John 4:4

If you know Jesus as your Savior, who is He who is in you?



Who is <u>he who is in</u> the world?

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Is there a sin in your life that seems too big and too hard to get rid of? If you are trying to get rid of it on your own, you are right! Pray. Ask God to forgive you of that sin and help you not to do it again. Then believe that God will keep His promise, and He will help you.

DAY - 4

When you are tempted to sin, remember to:

- Pray to God.
- Remember He is with you.
- Believe He can help you say no to sin.
